CENTURY VILLAGE—The 1800s village is located at Fryer Park, 4185 Orders Road. All buildings will be open from 2-4 p.m. the fourth Saturday, June-September. Restroom facilities are available next to the Village at the Fryer playground area. Free parking is available. Group tours can be scheduled. Cost is \$3 per student, \$5 per adult.

GROVE CITY MUSEUM—The museum showcases a history of Grove City and Southwest Franklin County townships. Over 1,000 items are on display. Visitors are encouraged to ask questions and, in some instances, touch or handle select items. Admission is free Monday through Friday, 10 am until 4 pm and Tuesdays until 8 pm. During Farmer's Market, the museum is open 8-Noon on Saturdays. Group tours can be scheduled. Cost is 3 per student, \$5 per adult.

GRANT-SAWYER HOMESTEAD—This historical 1840s era house and property can be viewed with a tour guide March through September. Tours limited to 10 people through the house at one time. Cost is \$5 per person, \$3 per person ages 5-18 and can be scheduled by calling the Museum, 614-277-3061.

WALKING TOURS—Walking tours of the Town Center are approximately one hour. Tours are April through October. Tours can be slightly abbreviated on request. It's a great opportunity to see and learn the history of older buildings in the Grove City's downtown. Walking tours are rain or shine. Cost is \$5 per person, \$3 per person ages 5-18.
